اَمَّا بَعْدُ،

فِيَا عِبَادَ اللّٰهِ، اتَّقُوا اللّٰهَ، اُوْصِيْكُمْ وَاِيَّايَ بِتَقْوٰى اللّٰهِ، فَقَدْ فَازَ الْمُتَّقُوْنَ.

Let us increase our righteousness to Allah the Almighty by doing all that He prescribes and leaving all that He prohibits. May we be blessed by Him in this life and the hereafter.

**Dear brothers and sisters,**

Death is a certainty and each of us will eventually face it. Although death is not desired and is greatly feared, it will surely happen to us. Only the time and



place will be determined by Allah the Almighty. Allah says in chapter 21 (surah al Anbia) verse 35:

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

كُلُّ نَفْسٍ ذَائِقَةُ الْمَوْتِ وَنَبَلُّوكُم بِالشَّرِّ وَالْخَيْرِ فِتْنَةً وَإِلَيْنَا تُرْجَعُونَ ﴿٣٥﴾

**Which means:** *“Every soul will taste death. And We test you with evil and with good as trial; and to Us you will be returned.”*

Although death is a certainty, we cannot aspire or want death or pray for death because we are unable to endure calamities and accidents, afflicted with illnesses that cannot be cured or facing stress and hardships. The prophet (pbuh) said in a hadith narrated by Imam Muslim which means:

*“Let none of you wish for death before the time comes, because when one of you dies, his deeds are terminated. Verily, the life of a believer is not increase but in goodness.”*

**Dear brothers and sisters,**

Although we are forbidden to aspire for death, we are however, encouraged to remember it, because remembering death can increase our good deeds and keep us away from committing sins and evildoing. The prophet (pbuh) said in a hadith narrated by Imam al Tarmizi:



اَكْتَرُوا مِنْ ذِكْرِ هَازِمِ اللَّذَاتِ

**Which means:** “Remember often the destroyer of pleasures (death)”

Thus, let us increase our good deeds and seek forgiveness from Allah the Almighty before our time is up.

Allah the Almighty says in chapter 62 (al Jumu'ah) verse 8:

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

قُلْ إِنَّ الْمَوْتَ الَّذِي تَفِرُّونَ مِنْهُ فَإِنَّهُ مُلَاقِيكُمْ ثُمَّ تُرَدُّونَ إِلَىٰ عَالِمِ الْغَيْبِ

وَالشَّهَادَةِ فَيُنَبِّئُكُمْ بِمَا كُنْتُمْ تَعْمَلُونَ ﴿٨﴾

**Which means:** Say, "Indeed, the death from which you flee - indeed, it will meet you. Then you will be returned to the Knower of the unseen and the witnessed, and He will inform you about what you used to do."

بَارَكَ اللَّهُ لِي وَلَكُمْ فِي الْقُرْآنِ الْعَظِيمِ، وَنَفَعَنِي وَإِيَّاكُمْ بِمَا فِيهِ مِنَ الْآيَاتِ وَالذِّكْرِ

الْحَكِيمِ، وَتَقَبَّلَ مِنِّي وَمِنْكُمْ تِلَاوَتَهُ، إِنَّهُ هُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ. أَقُولُ قَوْلِي هَذَا

وَأَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ الْعَظِيمَ لِي وَلَكُمْ، وَلِسَائِرِ الْمُسْلِمِينَ وَالْمُسْلِمَاتِ، وَالْمُؤْمِنِينَ

وَالْمُؤْمِنَاتِ، فَاسْتَغْفِرُوهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ الْعَفُورُ الرَّحِيمُ.
