Let us increase our righteousness to Allah the Almighty by doing all that He prescribes and leaving all that He prohibits. May we be blessed by Him in this life and the hereafter.

Dear brothers and sisters,

Islam greatly glorifies mothers and fathers. Honoring the mother or father, is not only giving them abundant wealth but also keeping good moral behavior. This is one of the characteristics of a believer who is loved by Allah the Almighty. Due to the highly respectable position of mothers and fathers in religion, Allah the

Almighty has obliged us to be kind to both of them. Allah the Almighty says in chapter 4 (Surah An Nisa) verse 36:

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

وَأَعْبُدُوا اللَّهَ وَلَا تُشْرِكُوا بِهِ شَيْئًا وَبِالْوَالِدَيْنِ إِحْسَانًا

Which means: “Worship Allah and associate nothing with Him, and to parents...”

This verse clearly shows that we are to honour and do good things for both parents in order to seek their blessings and to make them happy.

Dear brothers and sisters,

Children who love their parents will always preserve good morals and personality. Among the noble attitudes of children towards their parents are being gentle, courteous, not rebellious and always remembering their parents’ sacrifices and pray for forgiveness and their well-being.

The Prophet (pbuh) said in a hadith narrated by Imam Muslim from Abu Hurairah Radhiallahu anhu: “*He is doomed, he is doomed, he is doomed.*” “*The person whose parents, one or both of them, reach old age during his lifetime but he does not enter Paradise.*”

Remember! Our parents have sacrificed a lot for us. Thus, appreciating their sacrifices for only a certain period of time is not enough. In fact, we are required

to remember their sacrifices with lifelong affection. Allah the Almighty says in chapter 17 (surah al-Isra) verse 23:

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

وَقَضَىٰ رَبُّكَ أَلَّا تَعْبُدُوا إِلَّا إِيَّاهُ وَبِالْوَالِدَيْنِ إِحْسَانًا إِمَّا يَبُلُغَنَّ عِنْدَكَ

الْكِبَرَ أَحَدُهُمَا أَوْ كِلَاهُمَا فَلَا تَقُلْ لَهُمَا أُفٍّ وَلَا نَهْرُهُمَا وَقُلْ لَهُمَا

قَوْلًا كَرِيمًا ﴿٢٣﴾

Which means: “And your Lord has decreed that you not worship except Him, and to parents, good treatment. Whether one or both of them reach old age [while] with you, say not to them [so much as], "uff," and do not repel them but speak to them a noble word.”
