## Strive for the Benefits of the Last 10 Nights of Ramadan

أَمَّا بَعْدُ،

فَيَا عِبَادَ اللَّهِ، اتَّقُوا اللَّهَ وَأُوصِيكُمْ وَإِيَّايَ بِتَقْوَى اللَّهِ، فَقَدْ فَازَ الْمُتَّقُونَ.

Let us all increase our devotion towards Allah the Most High by performing all that He has decreed and abstaining from all that He has prohibited. Hopefully, we will be blessed in this world and in the Hereafter.

**Dear Brothers and Sisters,**

We are now approaching the last ten days of Ramadan. Let us contemplate the best deeds to carry out in order to reap the benefits of the few remaining days of Ramadan.

‘Aishah (may Allah be pleased with her), the wife of Prophet Muhammad (may Allah’s blessings and peace be upon him [PBUH]), described the practice of the Prophet (PBUH) when the end of Ramadan came in a *Hadith* narrated by Imam Muslim:

كَانَ النَّبِيُّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ يَجْتَهِدُ فِي الْعَشْرِ الْأَوَاخِرِ مَا لَا يَجْتَهِدُ فِي غَيْرِهِ

**Which means:** *“The Prophet (PBUH) used to strive hard (in worship) in the last ten nights of Ramadan as he never did at any other time.”*

The Prophet (PBUH) did not worship alone in the last 10 nights of Ramadan but he also woke his wife, Aishah, his daughter, Fatimah and his son-in-law, Ali ibn Abi Talib to join him. Aishah (may Allah be pleased with her) stated in a *Hadith* narrated by Imam al-Bukhari and Imam Muslim which means: *“When the last ten days of Ramadan began, the Prophet used to stay up at night, tighten his waist-wrap, and wake his family up (to pray).”*

#### **Dear Brothers and Sisters,**

The Prophet (PBUH) also encouraged his followers to seek *Lailatul Qadr* (The Night of Power) in the last 10 nights because the reward of worshipping on that special Night is multiplied by more than a thousand months. The Prophet (PBUH) mentioned in a *Hadith* narrated by Imam al-Bukhari and Imam Muslim which means: *“Seek the Night of Al-Qadr during the last ten (nights) of Ramadan.”*

He also performed *I'tikaf* (the act of staying while contemplating in a mosque) during the last 10 days of Ramadan starting on the night of the 21st until the night of *Eid* (the celebration at the end of Ramadan). Ibn Umar (may Allah be pleased with him) said in a *Hadith* narrated by Imam al-Bukhari and Imam Muslim which means: *“Allah's Messenger used to practice I'tikaf in the last ten days of the month of Ramadan.”*

We would like to appeal to the mosque committee members and officials to organize suitable activities in the last ten days of Ramadan so that we can continue to *I'tikaf*, recite the Qur'an and *dhikr*, as well as seek for the Night of Power and its blessings.

Allah the Most High mentioned in the Quran in Chapter 97 (*Surah Al-Qadr*), verses (*ayat*) 1-5.

**Which means:** “We sent it (the Quran) down on the Night of Power. What will explain to you what that Night of Power is? The Night of Power is better than a thousand months; on that night the angels and angel Gabriel descend on it on every errand with their Lord’s permission; [there is] peace that night until the break of dawn.”
