

Dear brothers and sisters

Islam is the only religion recognized by Allah the Almighty as a religion that is approved (*diredhai*). Allah the Almighty said in chapter 3 (surah Ali Imran) verse 19:

إِنَّ ٱلدِّينَ عِندَ ٱللَّهِ ٱلْإِسْلَامُ وَمَا ٱخْتَلَفَ ٱلَّذِينَ أُوتُواْ ٱلْكِتَابَ إِلَّا مِنْ الدِّينَ عَندَ ٱللَّهِ الْإِسْلَامُ وَمَا ٱخْتَلَفَ ٱلَّذِينَ أُوتُواْ ٱلْكِتَابَ إِلَّا مِنْ اللَّهِ مَا جَآءَهُمُ ٱلْعِلْمُ بَغْلَيْا بَيْنَهُمُ وَمَن يَكُفُرُ بِاَيْتِ ٱللَّهِ فَإِنَ



Which means: Certainly, Allah's only Way is Islam. Those who were given the Scripture did not dispute among themselves out of mutual envy until knowledge came to them. Whoever denies Allah's signs, then surely Allah is swift in reckoning.

Therefore, it is important for Muslims to preserve their beliefs (aqidah) so as not to be influenced and deceived by western ideologies that distort the beliefs of Muslims. This group is known as the liberalism and pluralism movement. They consider all religions to be the same.

Pluralism is the thinking that all religions are true; the followers of any religion are the same and all can enter heaven. The only difference is the path but the goal is the same which is towards God.

Pluralism is clearly contrary to the Islamic faith because only Allah the Almighty lays down the path and way of life that is based on the Quran and Hadith that is true and approved in this world and the hereafter. Allah the Almighty says in chapter 6 (surah al-An'am) verse153:

وَأَنَّ هَلَا صِرَطِى مُسْتَقِيمًا فَأَتَّبِعُوهُ وَلَا تَنَّبِعُواْ ٱلشُّبُلَ فَنَفَرَّقَ بِكُمْ

Which means: Indeed, that is My Path-perfectly straight. So follow it and do not follow other ways, for they will lead you away from His Way. This is what He has commanded you, so perhaps you will be conscious of Allah."

Dear brothers and sisters

Allah the Almighty only recognizes Islam as the only religion accepted by Him, but Islam does not advocate enmity and hatred towards other religions.

Therefore, Muslims must protect their faith so as not to be distracted by the thinking of this pluralism group because they place their religion on par with Islam.

Muslims should stay away from things that are contrary to Islamic law that can cause a person to become an apostate such as glorifying and cleaning idols in places of worship of non -Muslims by thinking that it is not against Islam in the name of religious pluralism that all religions are equal. As mentioned by the Prophet (pbuh) in a hadith narrated by Imam Abu Daud:

Which means: "He who imitates any people (in their actions) is considered to be one of them."

Dear brothers and sisters

Let us hold fast to the teachings of Islam because only Islam can save our families and us in this world and the hereafter. Let us not be easily deceived by those who claim to be fighters for religious freedom and equal human right; instead they bring heretical and misleading beliefs that damage the faith (aqidah) and bring down the glory of Islam.

Allah the Almighty says in chapter 3 (surah Ali Imran) verse 85:

Which means: Whoever seeks a way other than Islam, it will never be accepted from them, and in the Hereafter they will be among the losers.
