Dear brothers and sisters,

School holidays are a time that children look forward to because they want to be free from textbooks, extracurricular activities or even extra classes. This is the time for them to relax, have fun and do something they enjoy.

Actually, school holidays are not meant to be spent having fun only and forgetting about school. Parents must plan activities that will make the most of their children's school holidays.

It is important to remember that during the school holiday season, various incidents or tragedies often occur, such as road accidents, drownings and others. Therefore, help our children manage their holidays to ensure they are safe. Likewise,

help them to not get caught up in immoral and destructive social activities such as illegal motor racing, smoking cigarettes and vaping, and getting involved in drug addiction. It is our duty to educate them as the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said in a hadith narrated by Imam al-Bukhari:

كُلُّ مَوْلُودٍ يُولَدُ عَلَى الْفِطْرَةِ فَأَبَوَاهُ يُهَوِّدَانِهِ أَوْ يُنَصِّرَانِهِ أَوْ يُمَجِّسَانِهِ

Which means: "Every child is born upon the fitrah, and it is his parents who make him a Jew, a Christian, or a Magian."

Dear brothers and sisters,

Time is like gold, but most people sometimes forget and neglect to make the most of their free time and physical health. The Prophet (pbuh) said in a hadith narrated by Imam al-Bukhari:

نِعْمَتَانِ مَغْبُونٌ فِيهِمَا كَثِيرٌ مِنَ النَّاسِ الصِّحَّةُ وَالْفَرَاغُ

Which means: "There are two blessings that many people are deceived into losing: health and free time"

Remember that those who manage their time wisely by doing useful things are successful. On the other hand, people who are careless and waste time are losers. Allah the Almighty says in chapter 103 (surah Al-'Asr) verses 1-3:

Which means: "By the passage of time! Surely humanity is in grave loss, except those who have faith, do good, and urge each other to the truth, and urge each other to perseverance."

Dear brothers and sisters,

The responsibility of parents is not only to meet the physical and educational needs of their children, but more importantly, to instill religious values in them from a young age. We should take the example of Luqman al-Hakim in educating his children. Allah the Almighty says in chapter 13 (surah Luqman) verse 17 which means: "O my dear son! As parents, we should always pray for the well-being of our children because parents' prayers can make their children's lives to be blessed and protected from all disasters. Allah the Almighty says in chapter 25 (surah al-Furqaan) verse 74:

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Which means: "They are those who pray, "Our Lord! Bless us with pious spouses and offspring who will be the joy of our hearts, and make us models for the righteous."

Dear brothers and sisters,

There are various activities that can be planned and implemented during the school holiday season, such as inviting children to perform obligatory prayers in congregation at mosques. In addition, guide our children in learning the Quran. Invite them to help with household chores and visit relatives. Take our children to visit interesting places in our country, especially historical places or tourist attractions such as the highlands, waterfalls, rivers, beaches, national parks and other places if the weather permits. Children can also take advantage of public libraries and can be sent to participate in short-term courses such as ICT classes, fadhu ain classes, ibadah camps, skills classes or any other activity that is appropriate and can add value to the development of our children's identities.

In conclusion, as parents, we need to be concerned about our children's activities during school holidays. Fill our children's holidays with beneficial things, especially in deepening their religion knowledge and other skills. Manage our children's time well by monitoring their emotional, mental and physical development. Be careful in doing activities to avoid tragedies to our children. May our children be protected during this school holiday season.
