Dear brothers and sisters

The annual Hari Hol Pahang on May 22 is held to commemorate the death of the late Sultan Haji Ahmad Shah al-Mustain Billah Ibni Almarhum Sultan Abu Bakar Riayatuddin Al-Muadzam Shah and to remember his services and contributions to the religion, the people and the state of Pahang. Allah the Almighty says in chapter 22 (surah al-Haj) verse 41:

ٱلَّذِينَ إِن مَّكَّنَّهُمْ فِي ٱلْأَرْضِ أَفَ امُوا ٱلصَّلَوْةَ وَءَاتَوْا ٱلزَّكُوةَ وَأَمَرُواْ بِٱلْمَعْرُوفِ وَنَهَواْ عَنِ ٱلْمُنكَرِ ۗ وَلِلَّهِ عَنِقِبَةُ ٱلْأُمُورِ (١)

Which means: "They are those who, if established in the land by Us, would perform prayer, pay alms-tax, encourage what is good, and forbid what is evil. And with Allah rests the outcome of all affairs."

This verse explains that the responsibilities and terms of being an Islamic leader is to safeguard the sovereignty of Islam by calling people to perform prayers and pay tithe (*zakat*) as well as implement the commands of enjoining good and forbidding wrong (*makruf and nahi mungkar*). This is the main function of the Royal Institution in our country. The role of Tuanku Sultan as the head of religion and the ruling king in this country is to uphold the sovereignty of Islam and the interests of Muslims and the people as a whole.

The Royal Institution as caliphs on this earth, also plays a role in carrying out the trust of Allah the Almighty by spreading Islam through inviting people to believe in Allah and His Messenger and to do what Allah the Almighty commands and leave what He forbids so as to be elevated by Him. Allah the Almighty says in chapter 6 (surah al-An'am) verse 165:

Which means: "He is the One Who has placed you as successors on earth and elevated some of you in rank over others, so He may test you with what He has given you. Surely your Lord is swift in punishment, but He is certainly All-Forgiving, Most Merciful."

Dear brothers and sisters

Let us be thankful for being blessed with a peaceful life without major disputes. The stability and peace enjoyed by the people in this state and country is because we are ruled by the Institution of a sovereign King. We are also grateful that our state is still governed under the patronage of His Majesty al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin al-Mustafa Billah Shah Ibni Almarhum Sultan Haji Ahmad Shah al-Musta'in Billah.

We must protect our country as an Islamic country so that it is not taken over by the enemies of Islam. Therefore, we must maintain and safeguard the Royal Institution in order for it to continue ruling our country so that sovereignty of Islam is preserved.

This was the kind of governance made by the prophets when they were sent as Messengers to lead a country. It was also implemented by Prophet Sulaiman Alaihi Salam. He became a great ruler who was able to command mother nature other than humans. In fact, many rulers of other kingdoms converted to Islam because of the sovereignty he possessed and likewise the reign of Sultan Salahuddin al-Ayyubi was able to defeat the Crusaders and liberate Baitul Maqdis during his time. Remember that sovereignty will only be obtained if the country is governed with truth, fairness and free from lust. Reflect upon what Allah the Almighty says :in chapter 38)surah Sod(verse 26

يَكَ اوُدُ إِنَّا جَعَلُنَكَ خَلِيفَةً فِي ٱلْأَرْضِ فَأَحْكُمُ بَيْنَ ٱلنَّاسِ بِٱلْحَقِّ وَلَاتَتَبِعِ ٱلْهَوَى فَيُضِلَّكَ عَن سَبِيلِ ٱللَّهِ إِنَّ ٱلَّذِينَ يَضِلُّونَ عَن سَبِيلِ ٱللَّهِ لَهُمَ عَذَابٌ شَدِيدُ إِمَا نَسُواْ يَوْمَ ٱلْحِسَابِ أَنَّ

> Which means: O David! We have surely made you an authority in the land, so judge between people with truth. And do not follow your desires or they will lead you astray from Allah's Way. Surely those who go astray from Allah's Way will suffer a severe punishment for neglecting the Day of Reckoning."

يَتَأَيُّهَا ٱلَّذِينَ ءَامَنُوٓ أأَطِيعُوا ٱللَّهَ وَأَطِيعُوا ٱلرَّسُولَ وَأَوْلِي ٱلْأَمَرِ مِنكُمْ فَإِن نَنَزَعُنُمُ فِي شَيْءٍ فَرُدُوهُ إِلَى لَلَّهِ وَٱلرَّسُولِ إِن كُنُمُ تُؤْمِنُونَ بِٱللَّهِ وَٱلْيَؤ مِر ٱلْأَخِرْ ذَلِكَ خَيْرٌ وَأَحُسَنُ تَأُوبِلًا ()

Which means: O believers! Obey Allah and obey the Messenger and those in authority among you. Should you disagree on anything, then refer it to Allah and His Messenger, if you truly believe in Allah and the Last Day. This is the best and fairest resolution.
