Dear brothers and sisters

Islamic banking in Malaysia had been established for 40 years since Bank Islam Berhad started its business operations on 01 July 1983. أَعُوذُ بِٱللَّهِ مِنَ ٱلشَّيْطَنِ ٱلرَّجِيمِ

يَتَأَيَّهُا ٱلَّذِينَ ءَامَنُواْ ٱتَّقُواْ ٱللَّهَ وَذَرُواْ مَابَعِيَ مِنَ ٱلرِّبَوَّا إِن كُنتُم

فَإِن لَّمْ تَفْعَلُواْ فَأَذَنُواْ بِحَرْبٍ مِّنَ ٱللَّهِ وَرَسُولِهِ ﴿ وَإِن تُبْتُمُ فَلَكُمُ دُءُو شُ أَمَوَ لِحُمْ لَا تَظْلِمُونَ وَلَا تُظْلَمُونَ • (¹⁰)

Which means: "O you who have believed, fear Allah and give up
what remains [due to you] of interest, if you should be believers. And if you do not, then be informed of a war [against you] from Allah and His Messenger. But if you repent, you may have your principal - [thus]
you do no wrong, nor are you wronged."

This verse shows how great is the sin of usury in the eyes of Allah the Almighty and it should not be taken lightly at all. Thus, we should earnestly make sure that we and our loved ones do not belong in the category of people that Allah the Almighty and His Messenger despise as a result of falling into the sin of practicing usury.

Remember that all the possessions we have in this world are a test of our level of obedience to Allah the Almighty and it can be a source of grace and blessings from Allah the Almighty. The Prophet (pbuh) said in a hadith narrated by Imam Muslim:


Which means: "Jabir said: "The Messenger of Allah (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him) cursed the one who consumes riba and the one who pays it, the one who writes it down and the two who witness it, and he said: they are all the same."

Dear brothers and sisters


