Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The 16th of May is Teacher’s Day in our country. The theme of this year’s Teacher’s Day celebration is “*Murabbi Insani Generasi Madani*”. It is a day to appreciate the services and sacrifices of teachers as educators of the community, as well as inheritors of the duties of the prophets. This is in line

with the words of Allah the Almighty in the Quran in Chapter 2 (*Surah Al-Baqarah*) verse (*ayat*) 151:

كَمَا أَرْسَلْنَا فِيكُمْ رَسُولًا مِّنكُمْ يَتْلُوا عَلَيْكُمْ آيَاتِنَا وَيُزَكِّيكُمْ وَيُعَلِّمُكُمُ
الْكِتَابَ وَالْحِكْمَةَ وَيُعَلِّمُكُم مَّا لَمْ تَكُونُوا تَعْلَمُونَ ﴿١٥١﴾

Which means: *“just as We have sent among you a Messenger of your own to recite Our revelations to you, purify you and teach you the Scripture, wisdom, and [other] things you did not know.”*

Being a teacher is not easy because teachers bear a great responsibility to educate children to become productive citizens. They must be able to teach students with various behaviors and from different backgrounds. A teacher’s love for their students is similar to the parents’ love for their children.

As the National Laureate Dato’ Usman Awang conveys through the verses of his poem:

“Anyone who has matured on this day
Is by the virtue of an ordinary teacher
Whom with tenderness and patience, taught him to write and read”

Without the guidance of a teacher, it is not possible for us to know God and become a pious servant. As the words of wisdom say:

"لَوْ لَا مُرِّيِّ مَاعَرَفْتُ رَبِّي"

Which means: *“Without a teacher, I will not know my God”*

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today, the field of education is being tested by the rapid development of technology, especially when it comes to social media which is difficult to control. If not managed wisely, social media will affect its users negatively.

Teachers, as educators who are responsible for shaping the personality and identity of students, should be ready to adapt to technological advances to keep up with current demands. Dear Brothers and Sisters,

A school is a place for children to seek knowledge and experience, which is then applied in everyday life. Therefore, parents, guardians and the community are expected to support teachers to ensure that the learning process can shape moral and intelligent children.

The Prophet (peace be upon him [PBUH]) said in a *hadith* narrated by Ibn Majah:

أَكْرِمُوا أَوْلَادَكُمْ، وَأَحْسِنُوا أَدَبَهُمْ

Which means: “*Be kind to your children, and perfect their manners.*”

When every community member cares about children's education, there will be positive results. For example, when there are groups that organize activities to cultivate children's interests and skills, it will certainly increase the maturity and confidence of children to face the reality of life in the future.

Allah the Almighty mentions in the Quran in Chapter 5 (*Surah Al-Maidah*) verse (*ayat*) 2:

...وَتَعَاوَنُوا عَلَى الْبِرِّ وَالتَّقْوَىٰ وَلَا تَعَاوَنُوا عَلَى الْإِثْمِ وَالْعُدْوَانِ وَاتَّقُوا اللَّهَ إِنَّ اللَّهَ شَدِيدُ الْعِقَابِ .

Which means: "...help one another to do what is right and good; do not help one another towards sin and hostility. Be mindful of Allah, for His punishment is severe."

Let us respect teachers by practicing what is taught, trusting them fully and praying for their well-being so that we will always receive blessings and mercy from Allah in our lives in this world and the hereafter.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Let us together ensure that all parties play their roles in the development of children's education. As parents, we should not leave the task of education to the school alone. Schools play a role in developing intelligence, while parents are tasked with shaping their children's character and morals. Encourage children to study to the highest level to guarantee a comfortable life and improve the country in the future.

Allah the Almighty mentions in the Quran in Chapter 9 (*Surah At-Tawbah*) verse (*ayat*) 122:

وَمَا كَانَ الْمُؤْمِنُونَ لِيَنفِرُوا كَآفَّةً فَلَوْلَا نَفَرَ مِن كُلِّ فِرْقَةٍ مِّنْهُمْ طَائِفَةٌ لِّيَتَفَقَّهُوا فِي الدِّينِ وَلِيُنذِرُوا قَوْمَهُمْ إِذَا رَجَعُوا إِلَيْهِمْ لَعَلَّهُمْ يَحْذَرُونَ

Which means: “Yet it is not right for all the believers to go out [to battle] together: out of each community, a group should go out to gain understanding of the religion, so that they can teach their people when they return and so that they can guard themselves against evil.”
